**RESOLUTION FOR FUTURE USE OF  
Surface Transportation Program Urban (STPU) Funds  
for the  
Champaign-Urbana Urbanized Area Transportation Study (CUUATS)**

**WHEREAS**, the Champaign-Urbana Urbanized Area Transportation Study (CUUATS) in cooperation with the Illinois Department of Transportation, has a comprehensive, cooperative, and continuing (3C) planning process for transportation in compliance with Federal regulations for the urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been a long-standing practice to utilize the annual Surface Transportation Program Urban (STP-U) funds by CUUATS and the Technical and Policy Committees have realized the need for this resolution to maximize the number of funded projects that can be accomplished; and

**WHEREAS**, the federal legislation specifies that Surface Transportation Funds can be used for Urban Systems Projects which include improvements to collector and arterial streets which are Federal-aid Highways; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been a long standing practice of the Champaign-Urbana Urbanized Area Transportation Study (CUUATS) to utilize the annual Surface Transportation Program Urban (STP-U) funds at a 50/50 cost sharing basis for location studies and projects for construction and utility relocations only. Design and construction engineering and right-of-way and easement acquisitions are excluded for the use of STP (U) funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that all member agencies of CUUATS; the City of Champaign, the City of Urbana, the University of Illinois, the Village of Savoy, Champaign County and the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District agree;

- 1). to utilize the annual Surface Transportation Program Urban (STP-U) funds at a 50/50 cost sharing basis for location studies and projects for construction and utility relocations only. Design and construction engineering and right-of-way and easement acquisitions are excluded for the use of STP (U) funds; and
- 2) any exceptions must be approved by a vote of 4 of the 6 member agencies of the CUUATS Policy Committee listed above.
